The first meeting of the Internet Governance Forum (IGF) will be convened from 30 October -2 November 2006 in Athens, Greece. In accordance with the Tunis Agenda for the Information Society, "Internet Governance For Development" has been selected as the overall theme of the inaugural meeting, with capacity building as a



cross-cutting priority. The IGF Program consists of plenary sessions and workshops. The plenary sessions will discuss various topics including, openness, security, promotion of multilingualisim and local content, and internet connectivity in terms of policy and cost. Workshops will be held in parallel with the plenary sessions starting 31 October.

The workshop on "Enhancing Multi-Stakeholder Participation in ICT Policy-Making," organized within IGF framework by the Global Information Infrastructure (GIIC) and the World Information Technology and Service Alliance (WITSA), will explore the most effective channels for creating a policy framework, conducive to improved access to and use of ICT and the internet. Mr. Nizar Zakka, CEO of the Professional Computer Association of Lebanon and the Union of Arab ICT Associations (IJMA3), will walk the participants through the success stories taking place across the Middle-East and North Africa Region since the successful formation of the first-ever regional ICT association (IJMA3).
